California Political Climate

60 of 80 Assemblymembers are Democratic

30 of 40 Senators are Democratic

All constitutional officers are Democratic

Newsom geared toward DC & Redistricting effort, Proposition 50

2nd year of the 2-year legislative session begins in January New Senate leadership and committee chair and memberships ahead



Success in 2025

Medi-Cal Targeted Rate Increases still in effect and includes services provided in Urgent Care settings

Senator Menjivar Tour at Exer - April Sacramento Meetings - June

AB 1018 (Bauer Kahan) Automated Decision Systems – two year bill

SB 350 (Richardson) Medi-Cal Time & Distance Standards — SIGNED SB 306 (Becker) Prior Authorization - SIGNED AB 1041 (Bennett) Provider Credentialing — SIGNED



Headwinds for 2026

State Budget Deficit & Fluctuating Coverage Landscape

Augmented Intelligence Legislation

Antitrust Legislation

Increased scrutiny on investment & consolidation in health care



State Budget Challenges

2025-26 Budget Shortfall \$12 – 20 Billion

2026-27 Budget Shortfall (anticipated) \$30+ Billion each year

Revenue receipts slightly above forecasts due to Al investment



Fluctuating Coverage Landscape

State budget included eligibility provisions to close the budget shortfall

Jan 2026, new full-scope Medi-Cal UIS (ages 19 and older) will be frozen Jul 2027, Medi-Cal UIS (ages 19-59) will pay a \$30 monthly premium

HR 1 Impact - As many as 3.4mil Californians will lose coverage, and \$30bil loss in federal funding each year to CA

Expiration of federal financial support of CovCA subsidies as many as 600,000 enrollees could become uninsured
